The following documentation will be required to complete the application:

- 1. Medical evidence confirming the diagnosis, including a comprehensive medical history with documentation from the original diagnosing physician(s) (where possible) and the results of all relevant examinations, laboratory investigations and imaging studies.**  
- If the medical information is not in one of UEFA's official languages, (English/French/German), a clear summary of the medical condition and diagnostic tests must also be provided in English.
- 2. Written consent from medical practitioner**
